



Residential Unit Door Alarm System

Dear Parent/ Carer

As a matter of school security and safeguarding we have recently installed alarms on the individual bedroom doors and on the corridors on the residential unit to help protect and safeguard the young people who sleep over. This is done to ensure that young people feel safe in their rooms and also alerts staff on duty when the residential pupils have exited their rooms.

Once alarms are activated staff are notified on the alarm system which room door has been opened therefore allowing staff to monitor the pupil leaving the room until they return to ensure they do not disturb or enter another person's room or leave the unit during the night.

If a pupil leaves his room to use the bathroom once back in their rooms the alarms are reactivated either on the keypad or by a remote fob carried by staff.
